




Just as Emma's worry reached its peak, there was another knock at the door. Dad opened it to find the Magic Movers standing there again—this time looking a little embarrassed.

Here are 10 conversation-starting questions parents can use with 5-8 year old children after reading "The Magic Movers":

- 1. "How do you think Emma felt when she first learned they were moving? Have you ever felt that way about a change?"
- 2. "If you could use Magic Movers for your room, what would you want to make sure they didn't forget to bring?"
- 3. "Why do you think Simba the cat was hard to move? Where do you think he might have been hiding?"
- 4. "How would you decorate your room if you moved to a new house like Emma did?"
- 5. "Emma met a new friend at the end of the story. What do you think they might play together?"
- 6. "If you were a Magic Mover, what special magical powers would you want to have to help families move?"
- 7. "How do you think Emma felt when she woke up in her new room? What would you look at first in a new house?"
 - 8. "What would you miss most about our home if we moved somewhere else?"
- 9. "The Magic Movers came back to bring Simba. What do you think makes a person responsible, like remembering to check for pets?"
- 10. "Emma was scared but then found out things were okay in the end. Can you remember a time when you were worried about something but it turned out alright?"



These questions encourage children to:

- · Process emotions about change
 - · Use their imagination
 - · Develop empathy
- · Connect the story to their own experiences
- · Think about responsibility and problem-solving
 - · Recognize that feelings of worry can be temporary
 - · Express their preferences and value
